RPS announces 30 X 30 Initiative

FROM THE REGINA POLICE SERVICE

The Regina Police Service is hiring! And now, more than ever, we want to represent the community we serve. Women in policing, along with diversity and inclusion, are top of mind as we move forward in our recruiting efforts.

The 30 X 30 Initiative is aimed at increasing the diversity of police officers serving Regina. Police services which sign on to the initiative set a goal of having female officers make up 30 per cent of the sworn member contingent by the year 2030.

In 2021, the Regina Police Service had 24.8 per cent female representation in sworn officer positions (non-traditional roles). There are currently 102 female police officers at RPS of the 433 authorized police positions.

The 30 X 30 Initiative also asks police services to examine their practices and policies to determine if there are any barriers to women joining and being promoted. One of the



Regina Police Service's first steps in adopting the 30 X 30 Initiative was to survey current female police officers to gain insight that may help to identify and remove barriers.

In addition to 30 X 30, we also recently launched a new recruitment website to showcase what it's like to work for RPS. It takes a deep dive into the hiring process and our various community partnerships and programs such as: Treaty 4 Citizens Police Academy, the RPS Mentorship Program, and Scott Police Academy, to name a few.
