On The Road Ride & Fund Raiser set for Sept. 10

Prostate Cancer Support Regina will hold its On The Road Ride and Fund Raiser on Sat., Sept. 10.

Funds raised at the event will be going towards the Pasqua Hospital's Prostate Assessment Pathway Clinic and Future Men's Health in Regina and Saskatoon.

One out of eight Canadian men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer, being the most commonly diagnosed cancer in men.

On The Road Ride and Fund Raiser



Riding motorcycles or driving a classic vehicle, participants will take part on a 250-kilometre ride which begins at the Regina Southland Mall's Canadian Tire (north lot), continuing to the Sukanen Ship Pioneer Village and Museum which is located south of Moose Jaw. After a 90-minute stopover, the ride will continue to Chamberlain before finishing at Smitty's in the Normanview Mall in Regina at 3 p.m.

Ride tickets are \$37 which includes fees for two people/vehicle and museum admission.

Meal tickets are \$37 (steak, fries or salad and a drink) or \$32 (beef, chicken or veggie with fries or salad and a drink). The meal will begin at 3:30 p.m.

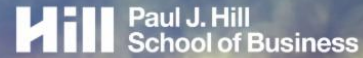
