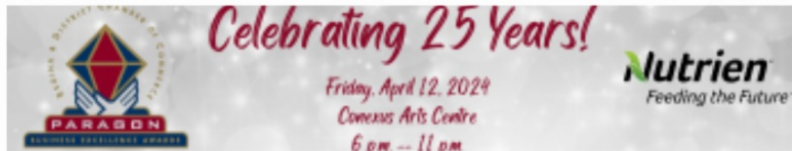



RRLIP & WES seek consultation participants

The Regina Region Local Immigration Partnership (RRLIP) and World Education Services (WES) to implement a new project to connect employers to immigrant talent in Regina: #ImmigrantsWork.



The aim of #ImmigrantsWork is to collaborate with employers and community partners in co-designing strategies that facilitate the identification, recruitment, employment, and retention of immigrant talent. This effort leverages the momentum of the #ImmigrantsWork Pilot Phase that produced the Employer Playbook, a digitized employer resource localized for the three pilot communities. Regina is one of five communities that joined #ImmigrantsWork Phase 2 in 2023.

As the populations of cities across Canada continue to age and diversify, we firmly believe that the integration of immigrant talent into our local labour market will lead to a stronger economy and enhance the resilience of our workforce.
