Discovery Week celebration helps SSC mark 35-year milestone

In 1978, a visionary group of women who were part of the Junior Service League recognized the critical need for greater public awareness and understanding of science and technology. Their dream? A dynamic museum experience that would revolutionize traditional learning. Fast forward to April 25, 1989, when their vision came to life with the opening of the Saskatchewan Science Centre.

In 2024 the Saskatchewan Science Centre marks its 35th year of operations. To commemorate this history a series of events and activities are planned throughout the year, beginning with a celebratory week planned for Discovery Week from April 22 to 28, 2024. During Discovery Week the SSC will:



- Welcome 314(+) students who may not otherwise experience the Saskatchewan Science Centre. Visiting students will have time on the exhibit floor, view an IMAX documentary film, and participate in a science-themed workshop. These visits were made possible through generous donations from local business through our Pi Month fundraising campaign.
- Celebrate Earth Day on April 22nd exploring the theme of "Planet vs. Plastics". Working with local community members and businesses we'll be exploring a variety of environmental topics throughout the day.
- Host the SSC's AGM which takes place at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, April 24th. Members are welcome to join the Board of Directors for an update on 2023 accomplishments and a glimpse of what's to come in 2024 and beyond.
- Celebrate our *35 Trips Around the Sun* with the return of the popular Adult Science Night on April 25th where we will be celebrating with a truly nostalgic event that is sure to make your hair stand up!

- Provide special showings of the IMAX film *The Dream is Alive*. This film was the first documentary film to be shown in the theatre when it opened in April 1991. This documentary takes viewers on an exciting journey over the Earth as it chronicles mankind's accomplishments in the realm of space exploration.
- Take visitors on a trip down memory lane with demonstrations and activities many recall from past visits to the SSC. The weekend will be filled with family-fun activities on the exhibit floor.

We all have memories of the first visit to the Saskatchewan Science Centre or a favourite IMAX film in Kramer IMAX Theatre. Throughout the year we'll be gathering these stories and sharing them in our community.

We encourage community members to take a moment and reflect on a cherished science centre memory, plan a visit during Discovery week (yes, adults can play too!), and consider leaving a legacy through a donation to the Discovery Fund or our Adopt-A-Laser campaign.

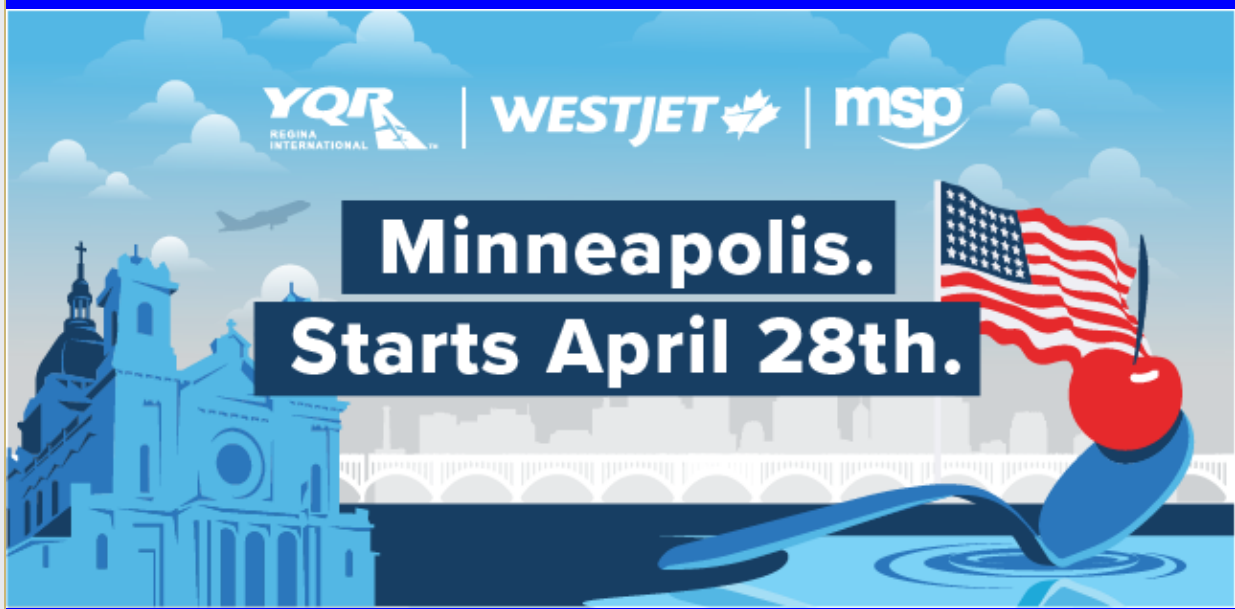

City hosting info meeting on April 23 re: Dewdney Ave. Revitalization project

The City of Regina is preparing to kick off construction the week of April 28th to transform Dewdney Avenue between Albert Street and Broad Street into a more aesthetically pleasing and vibrant corridor for the public to enjoy with improved pedestrian and driver safety.

Residents are invited to attend a public information session to learn how we are building a vibrant community with the revitalization of Dewdney Avenue. This come and go open house will showcase the upcoming phasing plans for construction along with the latest renderings of the future Dewdney Avenue corridor.

Please find important details of the information session below:

- Date: Tuesday, April 23, 2024
- Time 4:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.
- Location: The Docks (Weston Bakery Building) at 1377 Hamilton Street

The construction of the Dewdney Avenue Revitalization project will be completed in multiple phases over the next two years. Drivers should expect regular closures, lane restrictions and speed reductions along Dewdney Avenue between Albert Street and Broad Street. These restrictions ensure the safety of drivers, pedestrians and workers within the construction zone. Businesses along Dewdney Avenue will remain open throughout the construction season.

The first phase of construction is planned to begin the week of April 28th and includes lane restrictions between Albert Street and Broad Street. The City will advise of additional traffic restrictions as work progresses. Watch for signs, use caution and visit [Regina.ca/roads](https://regina.ca/roads) for up-to-date traffic restrictions.

While construction will limit parking on Dewdney Avenue, drivers can still park along the north-south streets throughout the Warehouse District. The City will also be providing parking on the Yards site throughout construction. There will be access and crosswalks to this temporary parking site at both Scarth Street and Hamilton Street.

Starting April 28, transit routes along Dewdney Avenue will be temporarily redirected to 8th Avenue throughout the duration of construction. Please check [TransitLive.com](https://transitlive.com) for up-to-date information.
