## SaskPower project extends Stage 4 written submission deadline

SaskPower is currently planning how it will supply power to Saskatchewan, now and into the future, and the project is nearing the end of its fourth stage.

The fourth stage of The Future Supply Plan -- 2030 and Beyond Project includes a survey that takes feedback on SaskPower's long-term supply plan draft summary. The response has been strong and as a result, the written submission deadline has been extended until Wednesday, May 15.

Stage 1 ran from September to November 2022 and engaged the public sector, asking how it wanted to participate, what supply options it would like to learn more about and the opportunities it sees for the future.

Stage 2, Understanding Priorities, ran from December 2022 to April 2023.

Stage 3, Exploring Future Power Supply Scenarios, began in October and is scheduled to run through mid-December.

Stage 4, Reviewing the Draft Long-term Plan, began in February 2024 and is is scheduled to be completed by the end of May.

Stage 5, Finalizing the Long-term Supply Plan, set to begin in June 2024.

Patton's presentation is scheduled from 6:30 p.m. to 6:50 p.m., with a Q & A session from 6:50 p.m. to 7:15 p.m.

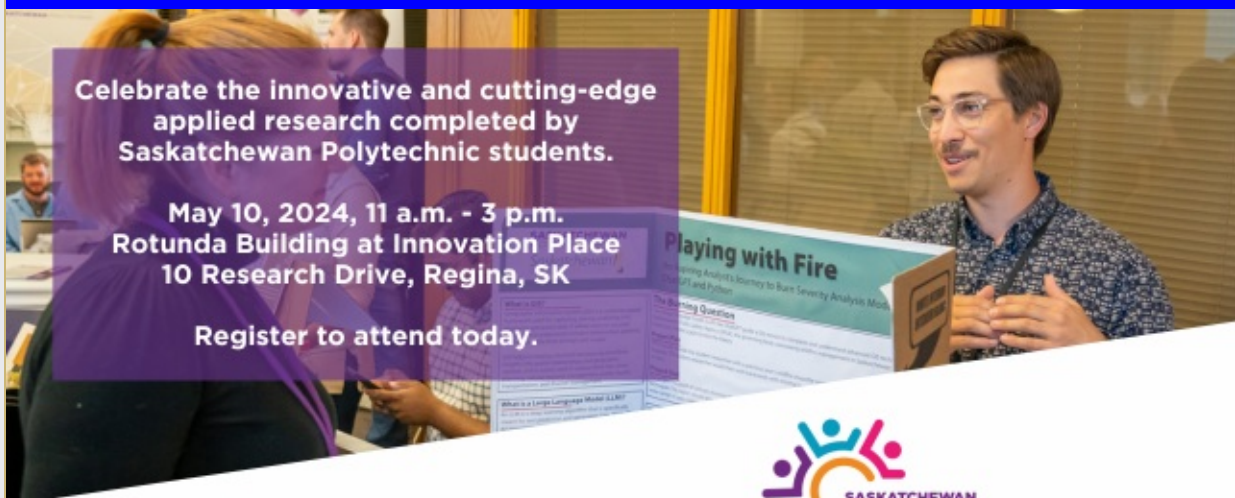
