RDCC event featured Fireside Chat with Mayor

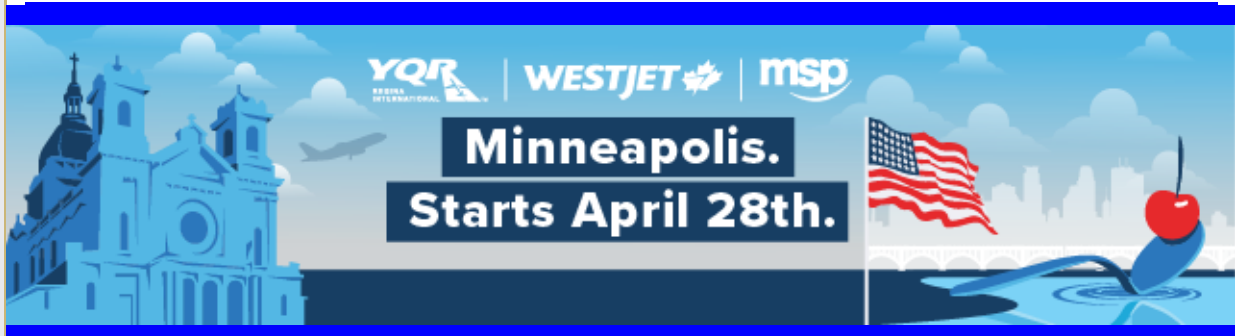
The Regina & District Chamber of Commerce Breakfast Series continued Tuesday morning with a robust crowd in attendance at the Atlas Hotel.
